You must be a 2020 Graduating High School Senior from an area high school, parochial or public, or homeschooled, and a participating Catholic that attends St. Jude Catholic Church Parish.

Information:

Scholarships will be awarded to St. Jude members who will be a 2020 graduating High School Senior in good standing and planning to further their education upon graduation. As long as you and/or your family are full time members of the St Jude Parish, attendance may be at a local high school or area Catholic High School (i.e. JP II) or Home School. The Scholarship will be presented prior to the student's Fall Semester.

To be eligible, the student must be accepted in an accredited two or four-year University, college, hospital, trade school, or other institution of higher learning. The student is expected to provide proof of acceptance to the Knights of Columbus *prior* to the awarding of the scholarship.
